ADDITIONAL COMMENTARY:

Maximum capacity figures for day services outlined above are based on the capacity of each day centre **building** as required by the Care Inspectorate and therefore do not reflect maximum capacity for each **service** as a whole (which also includes community, outreach, project and home).

Emergency respite was sustained during the pandemic and creative options utilised to develop other forms of support. Services continue to work with families to ensure community-based respite is promoted to ensure choice and to meet need via Self Directed Support and direct payments. Within North Aberdeenshire for example the Learning Disability respite service has been consolidated to one 24/7 building, moving from a partially accessible and partially available respite resource split over 2 sites to a single year-round respite resource designed to provide sustainability and extended provision (alongside this the provision of an 'as required' flat/accommodation in Fraserburgh remains to be completed presently impacted by staffing levels).

Work continues to develop sustainable and enhanced respite provision in line with our local strategies, recognising how demand for respite use across both learning disability and older people's services changed during the pandemic and will continue to change as we transition out of the Covid affected period.

We are seeking to re-establish day care provision within older people's care homes across Aberdeenshire which are currently registered with the Care Inspectorate to provide this 'support service' – this would provide a total capacity of 24 additional places commencing from 1st August 2022.

Separately through the HSCP's Learning Disability Strategy we have also agreed a clear strategic direction for community-based, inclusive activities for people who use Training and Skills Development services. Aberdeenshire has a wide range of such services, some very small within rural communities and some developed in response to local need, and there is a desire to continue to support that growth giving options to service users as part of Self-Directed Support. Following a process of service review during 2021 including engagement with service users and providers, Direct Awards will be issued to a range of providers commencing 1st July 2022.
