Shona Morrison, COSLA President

Councillor Shona Morrison was elected as the 16th President of the Convention of Scottish Local Authorities in June 2022.

Councillor Morrison is currently serving her second term as a Moray Councillor for Fochabers Lhanbryde. In the previous term, and as part of the Council's administration, she sat on the board of NHS Grampian and chaired the Moray Integration Board. Having worked as a mental health nurse before moving into politics, Councillor's Morrison's

appointment to both boards has provided constant challenge and learning.

From 2018, Councillor Morrison served as Convener of Moray Council and as Civic Head, representing the Council both locally and nationally. As well as the above roles, Councillor Morrison sat on several of the Council's service committees including Economic Development and Infrastructure, Community Planning and Education.
