Warm Scots Welcome

The Minister's office asked me to get in touch. I want to apologise for the delay in responding to your email of 5 May "Update: Estates offer to Ukrainian refugees". Please feel free to email me at any time, and I include my personal contact number at the bottom of this email.

The Scottish Government (as 'super sponsor') has now sponsored more than 7,000 Ukrainians, this is in addition to the more than 3,000 sponsored by private individuals in Scotland. In total, across both sponsorship routes, around 3,500 people have now arrived in country. We have established a network of 'Welcome Hubs', delivered in partnership by local government and the third sector, at Edinburgh airport, Glasgow city and airport, as well as Cairnryan Port. These hubs provide meals, comfortable accommodation, trauma support and access to translation to all super sponsor arrivals.

What is key is reducing the time spent in hotels by matching super sponsor visa holders with longer-term accommodation as quickly as possible. A national matching service, delivered by COSLA, is already working hard to find longer-term accommodation for those in hotels. This includes considering local authority and housing association stock across the length and breadth of Scotland, and of course the generous offers of the public. It is clear all these housing options will be needed to meet demand.

More than 20,000 Scots have registered an interest in hosting a Ukrainian through the UK Government's 'Homes for Ukraine' campaign. The Scottish Government has contacted this huge volunteer network to ask whether they would be interested in hosting a super sponsor visa holder and to find out more details about their property. For those who wish to proceed, information is automatically fed to the relevant local government to conduct checks so that host details can be entered onto the database for use by the national matching service.

I can see the letter of 26 April from the Minister for Culture, Europe and International Development included the link to this registration page. This is the simplest way to capture offers and provide the required details about the accommodation being offered. I do appreciate you had hoped to lead a single reply for all your members, however, this may be unwieldy for SLE to manage a replica survey in-house and we would need data-sharing arrangements between our organisations once completed.

To make this as simple as possible, I have therefore asked our data team to re-open a standalone survey for use directly by your members. You will only need to issue the link to your members for completion and we will receive the data on this side once submitted. The questionnaire will ask questions about rooms, accessibility of properties, pets, language and preferences.

I hope this helps and is a logical way forward. Let me know if you've any queries. I copy to [REDACTED] who will be able to create a bespoke route and provide you with the link.

Dear Minister,

It was great to meet you by chance the other week in Parliament. When we spoke I very briefly mentioned SLEs coordinated offer from 50 of our members of accommodation and employment for Ukrainian refugees. This is something on which we have already corresponded with your officials. Initially it was suggested our members all apply individually through the Super Sponsor / Homes for Ukraine schemes, but we were keen to pursue a more coordinated approach in order to save the Scottish Government, and our members, time and resource and make the process as efficient as possible for all involved. To that end we were asked on 29 March by [REDACTED] (Scottish Government) to provide details of the estates behind this coordinated offer, including their location and how many people they could host. We collated the information asked for and submitted it as requested, but we have not heard anything further.

I am writing now in the hope you can provide us with an update on the progress of our offer/collated information as we are keen to advise our members on the next steps and ultimately to see refugees provided with somewhere safe and welcoming to live in Scotland.

Thank you for your correspondence of 22 March 2022 regarding accommodation and employment for Ukrainian refugees. Please accept my apology for the delay in responding to your correspondence. I trust you will find the information in my reply helpful.

The First Minister and Scottish Government take the current humanitarian crisis extremely seriously. We would like to thank the people of Scotland for the huge groundswell of compassion, generosity, and support shown for the people of Ukraine. We welcome your support and solidarity for the millions of people who have had to flee war, and of course, those who remain in the country.

People's very generous offers of accommodation and sponsorship are greatly appreciated. People in Scotland willing to volunteer and provide homes for Ukrainians arriving through the sponsorship scheme are encouraged to sign up at the Homes for Ukraine portal - [Homes for Ukraine – Homes for Ukraine – Local Sponsorship Scheme for Ukraine \(campaign.gov.uk\)](#).

The requirement to have people matched with an individual sponsor before they are allowed entry to the UK could delay the time taken to reach the UK. That is why the Scottish and Welsh Governments have offered to become 'super sponsors'. By acting as initial 'super sponsors' we can allow large numbers to come to Scotland quickly – with an initial commitment to 3,000 in Scotland, and ultimately, at the very least, a proportionate share of all who come to the UK. This means that when a displaced person from Ukraine is looking for a sponsor they can choose the Scottish Government as that sponsor. These details will be shared with Scottish Government so that appropriate matches can be arranged while immediate support is provided to those arriving.

Working with partners, the Scottish Government through our Warm Scots Welcome programme will welcome people to Scotland and arrange the provision of accommodation, safeguarding and access to services - just as we have done successfully to offer wraparound support to displaced people and refugees in the past. Once people are here, and accommodated temporarily, we will then work with local partners to match people with longer term accommodation, including from members of the public who are volunteering rooms, as well as support. We want Scotland to be a safe, secure home for as long as people need and again thank you for your offer of support to help us in that aim.

We are extremely grateful for all the offers of employment we have had and continue to receive to date. Upon arrival it is important that we offer our guests time to rest, recuperate, and in many unfortunate cases - grieve. It is also worthwhile to bear in mind a lot of the first arrivals will undoubtedly have caring responsibilities.

Currently all offers of employment continue to be collated and forwarded to relevant business organisations who have agreed to manage the process. The immediate priority at the moment is the welfare of the new arrivals and assessment of their individual needs and requirements, therefore there may be a delay before these kind offers can be actioned.

Once established, new arrivals to Scotland will be directed to relevant organisations for offers of further assistance and to make the appropriate connections to ensure they settle well in their new communities. More information will be provided for potential employers in the very near future.

As with other groups who have come to Scotland, we know that people displaced from Ukraine who come here will make a valuable contribution to communities the length and breadth of the country. They will have a home here as long as they need.
