Dear Mr Macpherson

Thank you again for meeting with Mark on Thursday to talk about his Proposed Scottish Employment Injuries Advisory Council Bill.

I am getting in touch to follow-up on your offer for Mark to have input in the preparation of the upcoming consultation on employment injuries assistance, which we understood you would consider what information can be shared to aid that. It would be useful to know what the current questions are, specifically the areas of consultation around what the new benefit will look like, and the options you are consulting on for the scrutiny, advisory and research arrangements including membership of those arrangements. We understood the timetable for the consultation would be for the consultation to launch before the summer recess, and the analysis to be undertaken by end of the calendar year.

Mark also welcomes your offer to have an open door for you to both share further information, and agreed this will be useful. Mark also confirmed he would open to discuss timing of commencement and establishment of the council. With this in mind it would be sensible to arrange a follow-up meeting in mid-May, to discuss Mark's preparation for lodging the bill.
