When notes apply to an entire column the note is contained within the column title.</p> <p>[c] indicates an estimate is below reliability threshold due to small sample size or no people were recorded in this category in the survey.</p> <p>[d] indicates secondary suppression due to primary suppression of data in other cells.</p> <p>[u] indicates an estimate is based on a small sample size. This may result in less precise estimates, which should be used with caution. Cells are also coloured grey to indicate this note.</p> <p>Data is subject to sampling variability and is not seasonally adjusted.</p> <p>Estimates are for those aged 16 to 64 who have never worked.</p> <p>Levels are rounded to the nearest hundred and proportions are rounded to one decimal place. Proportions are based on unrounded estimates.</p> <p>Proportions use people aged 16 to 64 who have never worked excluding those who did not know and/or refused to answer.</p> <p>Data are provided for regions of Scotland and where possible Local Authority areas.
