I'm pleased to be able to invite you to visit the passenger ship M/S Ambition, docked in King George V Dock, Glasgow, on **Wednesday 19 October from 14.30 pm to 15.30 pm**.

You will have the opportunity to see it in action providing temporary accommodation to displaced people from the Ukraine as part of our Warm Scottish Welcome. There will be a tour of facilities on board and a short session with myself and officials to answer any questions you may have.

The ship, including its communal spaces, is people's home for the period they are aboard and as such we are mindful of the need to respect and preserve their privacy, without media or additional disturbance.

The Scottish Government's Super Sponsor Scheme has now offered sanctuary to more than 15,000 people following the humanitarian crisis caused by Russia's illegal invasion of Ukraine. Unfortunately, there is currently no end to the war in sight. M/S Ambition enables us to continue to provide safe and secure accommodation for those who need it and, along with M/S Victoria I based in Leith, both ships have been positively received by people on board.
