As usual, things on the forestry side are a little complicated, but the overall message is that we are continuing to invest the £150m from the Low Carbon Fund in our forests and woodlands, for nature, for jobs and for public amenity.

On the positive side for this year we can definitely point to an increase in the total allocation to the Forestry Grant Scheme in 2022-23, to fund another increase in the woodland creation target to 15,000 hectares. Ross – can you give the exact figures and the % increase, please.
