



Disabled Persons' Parking Places (Scotland) Act 2009

Report on Performance of Functions

1 April 2011 to 31 March 2012

The DPPPA came into force on 1 October 2009. The Act requires local authorities to identify every on-street and off-street advisory disabled parking place within their areas and to commence the statutory process to introduce disabled persons' parking orders.

Purpose of report

This report sets out action taken by Glasgow City Council in fulfilment of the Disabled Persons' Parking Places (Scotland) Act 2001 which requires the council to publish a report annually on the performance of its functions in fulfilment of the act.

This report is the first of the annual reports and covers the period between 1 April 2011 to 1 31 March 2012. The information provided is in accordance with Part 1 of the Schedule to section 11(2) of the Act.
