Subject: UCI World Cycling Championships

Good Afternoon

As indicated on the morning call, I am pleased to confirm that Scottish Ministers have agreed to support the hosting of the 2023 World Championships in Glasgow and Scotland. This support means that:

1. The Scottish Government will provide the balance of the funding necessary to stage the event (on the basis of the current budget forecast) after all other contributions have been taken into account; and
2. The Scottish Government commits to underwrite the event.

This commitment is made on the basis that:

- Glasgow City Council, UK Sport and British Cycling contribute their agreed shares towards the budget (and efforts continue to secure additional public funds and commercial income);
- The Championships and supporting activity are designed and delivered in a way that secures Scotland-wide benefits;
- There is an appropriate distribution of the event disciplines across Scotland as a means of achieving broad benefits;
- Best use is made of commercial and local expertise as well as existing assets;
- Appropriate governance arrangements are put in place reflecting the differing levels of financial contribution and exposure to risk.

Further down the line there will probably need to be a formal Minute of Agreement between us but, as we discussed earlier, the focus at the moment is seeing some movement around the Heads of Terms so that we can get a positive result in Denmark.

Thanks to everyone for your patience and support in helping us to secure this outcome.

Thanks. Copying in Bettina for awareness, although she is on leave until Wednesday (and Jonathan is recovering from a cycling accident).

It would be good to be kept abreast of where the progress leaves us financially. As discussed yesterday, we are agreed that we are working within the £50.75m (+ “Glasgow’s” £2m) ceiling with a view to keeping as much of our contingency intact as possible. Redacted s30(b).

I will need to run the next version of the HofT past SG legal advisers before it can be finally agreed with UCI, particularly if SG is the signatory. Please allow for that process in your thinking (I think I can get a prompt response if you indicate when it might be ready and I will tee them up).

We will explore options for the announcement with Ministers once the action plan is available. It may be too early to be definitive about attendance in the current febrile political climate but we can get some holding slots in diaries.

2023 UCI Cycling World Championships

I am writing to you with less than 18 months to go until the 2023 UCI Cycling World Championships, the biggest cycling event the world has ever seen, which will take place in Glasgow and across Scotland. Work is progressing at pace to ensure this unprecedented event is a success. At this key time, I am seeking your renewed commitment and support to ensure that the event delivers on our vision to be a policy led event that is a catalyst for behaviour change across Scotland, with impacts beyond 2023.

The 2023 UCI World Championships provides a unique opportunity and platform to celebrate the Power of the Bike and promote Scotland globally whilst contributing to key policy areas such as Participation, Tourism, Industry, Sport, Events and Transport.

Following recommendations of a recent Gateway Review, an overarching Policy Impact Plan is being finalised which sets out the wider policy ambitions for the event. Importantly this captures activity across policy areas and identifies who is responsible for leading and delivering projects. EventScotland is the lead for the Events policy pillar. In addition, [section 30 \(b\)](#) Much of the focus of the Cycling Cabinet and 2023 Cycling World Championships Board going forward will be to help drive the key projects where I believe the event can directly contribute and make the greatest impact, providing constructive challenge and assuring progress is on track. The Policy Advisory Group associated with the event will also transition into an assurance role, ensuring that the policy workstream leads are delivering to agreed timescales.

I recognise this renewed focus on achieving our policy ambitions will require investment and resourcing of this area of work. To ensure this is possible I am writing to you today to ask that your organisation nominates a lead representative that will be the go to person for policy work and to ask you to agree that you will commit appropriate resources wherever possible to help deliver the policy priorities that your organisation is responsible for. I will be meeting with my Ministerial colleagues over the coming period and will also be asking that they provide support across their portfolios to give us the best opportunity of delivering our ambitions.

I look forward to your continued support and input as we work towards making the 2023 UCI Cycling World Championships a successful event that delivers a lasting legacy for cycling in Scotland.
