All

We have been trying to arrange a meeting between Police Scotland, Mr Brown and Ms Gilruth over summer recess to discuss the Kenmure St incident as agreed before the end of the Parliamentary term. Given annual leave plans it is proving difficult to pin a date down that suits Ministers and the Chief Constable.

I am conscious that we are now looking at a date in September for this discussion if it is to be a standalone meeting. Mr Brown meets with the Chief Constable on a fortnightly basis so we could look to add it to the agenda for one of those meetings if there is no merit in having a longer meeting.

Grateful for your advice on how best to proceed and if this meeting is still required given the time that has passed. I will then seek Mr Brown's views based on your advice.
