You were not consulted on this most recent application. However you were consulted previously on a very similar application which proposed 3 houses in a similar layout to those proposed by this application. Our reference was TP/ED/20/0904 and I have attached the response form your information. Given the similarities with the previous proposal and the time that has passed since the unauthorised felling we didn't consider it necessary to consult Scottish Forestry again.

The trees that previously occupied the site were not protected by either a Tree Preservation Order or by virtue of a conservation area designation so did not require any consent from East Dunbartonshire Council to fell them. We therefore have never pursued any enforcement action in relation to the felling as they did not constitute a breach of planning control and would not be in a position to impose any fines.
