Notes

- BEIS outlined what changes they made to document – it was essentially bringing it in line with their research publication standards, it wasn't amending the recommendations. No comments from the steering group on this.
 - BEIS outlined that the research would be published on WSP's website by the end of the year (mid December) Wales have recently published revised planning guidance that includes noise, I think its now the Department for Levelling Up Housing and Communities identified that NPPF prospectus for planning was launching in mid December and contained some information on onshore wind particularly repowering. The Scottish Government identified that the onshore wind policy statement was due for publication around this time. UK Government took away an action to consider delaying publication until after the new year given other publications.
 - UK Government have worked up comms lines which they have committed to sharing after the meeting.
