



## FIREWORKS AND PYROTECHNICS BILL

The Bill will require an expedited timetable for its parliamentary passage if it is to have commenced by Bonfire Night 2022, with two measures (the proxy purchasing offence and restricting the days on which fireworks can be set off) in place for this date.

The principal risk identified to the timetable are late-running policy instructions due to stretched resources during ongoing stakeholder engagement.
