The proposed reduced speed limit is to protect users, as the existing boundary fence that separates the road from the water is no longer fit for purpose. It doesn't have the appropriate containment for this situation.

Amey have a scheme currently being designed to upgrade to current standards, however the risk of vehicles passing through the existing barrier in the event of a collision remains. The reduction in speed limit is a mitigation to reduce the potential of such a collision. It is proposed to have in place until the upgrade works are complete.
