I note the urgency in relation to COP27, and that this builds on commitments given by the FM at COP26. Given that climate change is one of Ministers' key priority areas, I am content that this should continue forward. However, my understanding is that this particular £5m loss and damage fund would be funded from the Climate Change Fund- the commitment which was made at COP26 to increase to £36m over the lifetime of the parliament. This remains a pressure and will need to be addressed through further prioritisation in the upcoming 23/24 and future years budget process to ensure all commitments can be delivered over time.
