As discussed, please see below details with regard to seed source. The majority of our trees were being delivered from but towards the end of the planting, they informed us that they could not complete our order. We then got in touch with some other nurseries who confirmed they could provide our required seed zones to complete the remainder of our planting. I can forward on the emailed call off orders which highlight the requested seed zone if required. Our planters then received the last few thousand trees and finished off the scheme. We were supplied with the seed certificate about a month after along with the invoice but I did not pick up on the lines with the incorrect seed sources. We have unfortunately planted 6,050 trees out with the agreed seed zones. This equates to 1.2% of the total amount of trees planted on the scheme. As you will have noticed from your site visit, there is going to be a substantial beat up requirement for this upcoming planting season. We know where the 6K trees are on site so we will be able to replace these with agreed/ local seed sourced trees. Let me know if your require any further information on this.
