Dear [REDACTED],

I wanted to ensure that you have prior notice of the expected media coverage that Glasgow and Clyde Rape Crisis are likely to receive from Saturday, 11 October onwards. The content of the media coverage focuses on GCRC's need to sustain its vital services – whose demand has grown for the fourth consecutive year from women and girls- and to plan for 2026/27 with more financial certainty than it currently has.

Particularly, this relates to the future of the Delivering Equally Safe Fund overseen by the Scottish Government. It will express our genuine concern that our vital services risk further reductions, or worse still, closure, if we are not able to secure the financial stability we need from this national fund as soon as possible.

We will also be launching our Holyrood Election 2026 Manifesto shortly after this to reiterate the need for increased security and understanding of the expertise we possess and the specialist services we provide amongst Scotland's politicians, and, more importantly, the women and girls who will be let down if we can't secure our future.
