

JOINT HOUSING POLICY AND DELIVERY GROUP
Journey and Support Subgroup Progress Update
8 November 2016

The Subgroup has met twice. Following discussions with the chair of the Home and Place Subgroup, we agreed that we would take on over sight of actions:

- 14 sustainability
- 15 fuel poverty
- 16 energy efficiency

The Home and Place Subgroup also agreed to include the following actions in their work:

- 22 older people and diversifying tenures
- 32 new homes at scale through the PRS
- 33 private and public interface in development opportunities

However, we have also agreed that we want to keep a watching brief on action 22.

Over the first two meeting we have reviewed progress and the current status of the following actions:

Actions 29 to 34 will be reviewed at our third meeting on 30 November.

Following on from reviewing the status of current actions the group will focus on further steps to progress those actions agreed as red or amber.

The group has also acknowledged that the action plan is now 2 years old and will give some consideration to other actions that should be considered. In particular, the group is concerned that there is insufficient focus on issues around homelessness and that progress around some aspects of health and social care integration is inconsistent and or too slow.
