The sixth meeting of the Ministerial Forum (EU Negotiations) was held today in 70 Whitehall, London and was chaired by the Minister for the Constitution, Chloe Smith MP, and the Parliamentary Under Secretary of State at the Department for Exiting the EU, Robin Walker MP.

- From the Welsh Government: the Minister for Housing and Regeneration, Rebecca Evans AM; the Cabinet Secretary for Economy and Transport, Ken Skates AM; and the Cabinet Secretary for Energy, Planning and Rural Affairs, Lesley Griffiths AM

In the absence of Ministers from the Northern Ireland Executive, Paul Brush, Deputy Director of EU Future Relations, Northern Ireland Civil Service, was also in attendance.

The five principal agenda items at the meeting were an update and discussion of the latest state of EU negotiations; a discussion on transport; financial services; services; and energy, in the context of our future relationship with the EU.
