<b>Action Text</b>	Scottish Government will ask Lead Clinicians in CAMHS to help develop a protocol for admissions to non-specialist wards for young people with mental health problems, where such an admission is clinically and socially appropriate for the young person. This is to ensure that safe and appropriate care can be provided in the non-specialist setting and responds to a Mental Welfare Commission recommendation. This is national activity drawing on local expertise.
