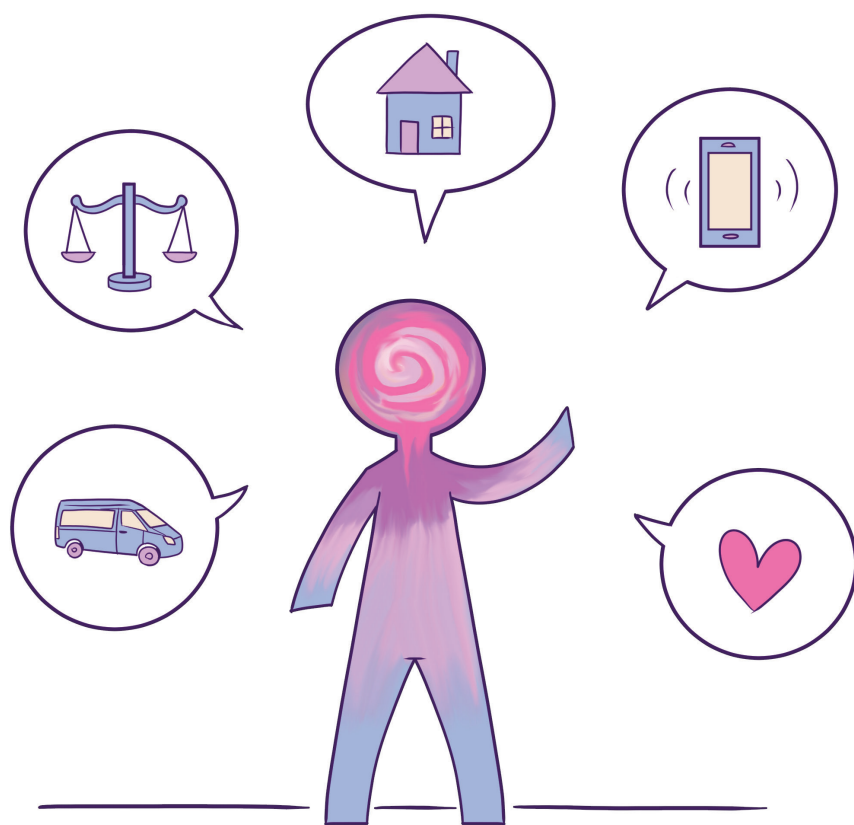

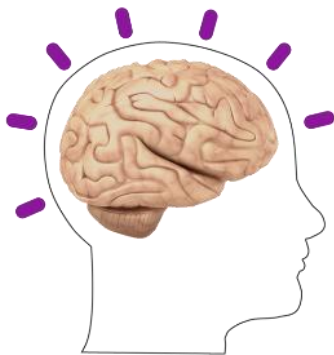
In this paper we will write **people** when we mean neurodivergent people and people with learning disabilities. This is so that we can be shorter.



The LDAN Bill needs to show clearly who would be covered by it.



This is so that we can clearly say who the Bill would be able to help.



We think the term **neurodivergence** could be used. It could describe a range of people who the Bill will cover.



Neurodivergence was supported by most people responding to our consultation.

What could the Bill say?



The LDAN Bill could use the words neurodivergence and neurodivergent people.



The Bill could list the conditions that are included in neurodivergence.



For example, learning disabilities, Down's Syndrome, attention deficit hyperactivity disorder (ADHD) and autism.



We think conditions that would not be included in the Bill should also be listed.



We are still thinking about which conditions should not be in the Bill.



We will make sure that the Bill can be updated as we learn more about neurodivergence.



We think people could benefit from the improvements the Bill could make without needing a diagnosis.
