

Scottish Infected Blood Support Amendment Scheme 2020

The Scottish Ministers make the following Scheme in exercise of the powers conferred by section 28 of the Smoking, Health and Social Care (Scotland) Act 2005 and all other powers enabling them to do so.

Commencement and interpretation

1. (1) This Scheme comes into force on 1st April 2020.
- (2) In this Scheme, “the Principal Scheme” means the Scottish Infected Blood Support Scheme 2017¹.

Amendment of the Principal Scheme

2. The Principal Scheme is amended as follows.
3. In paragraph 18(3), in sub-paragraph (a) for “paragraph 4” substitute “paragraphs 4, 8 and 9”.
4. In schedule 1-
 - (a) in paragraph 3A(a), for “£6,300” substitute “£6,407”.
 - (b) in paragraph 3A(b), for “£18,900” substitute “£19,221”.
 - (c) in paragraph 4, for “£20,250” substitute “£20,594”.
 - (d) in paragraph 6, for “£6,300” substitute “£6,407”.
 - (e) in paragraph 7, for “£18,900” substitute “£19,221”.
 - (f) in paragraph 8, for “£4,725” substitute “£4,805”.
 - (g) in paragraph 9, for “£14,725” substitute “£14,416”.
5. In schedule 2-
 - (a) in paragraph 4, for “£27,000” substitute “£27,459”.
 - (b) in paragraph 7, for “£27,000” substitute “£27,459”.
 - (c) in paragraph 8, for “£20,250” substitute “£20,594”.
6. In schedule 3-
 - (a) in paragraph 3, for “£27,000” substitute “£27,459”.
 - (b) in paragraph 5, for “£27,000” substitute “£27,459”.
 - (c) in paragraph 6, for “£20,250” substitute “£20,594”.
