

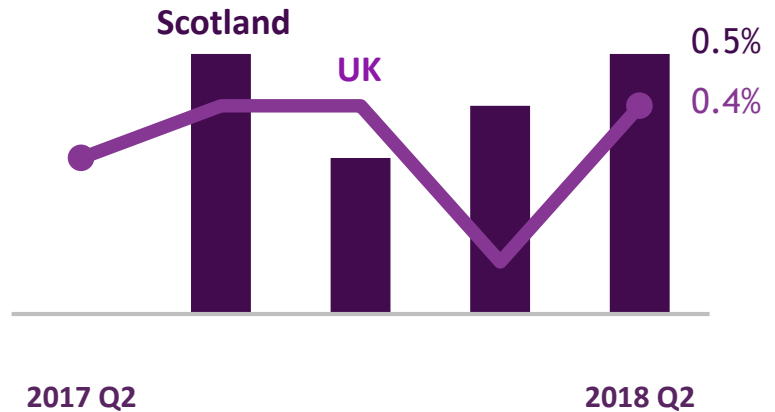


**Scottish GDP grew by 0.5% in the second quarter of 2018**

The quarterly growth rate is unrevised compared to the first estimate published on 19 September.

UK GDP growth was 0.4%.

Change in GDP compared to the previous quarter

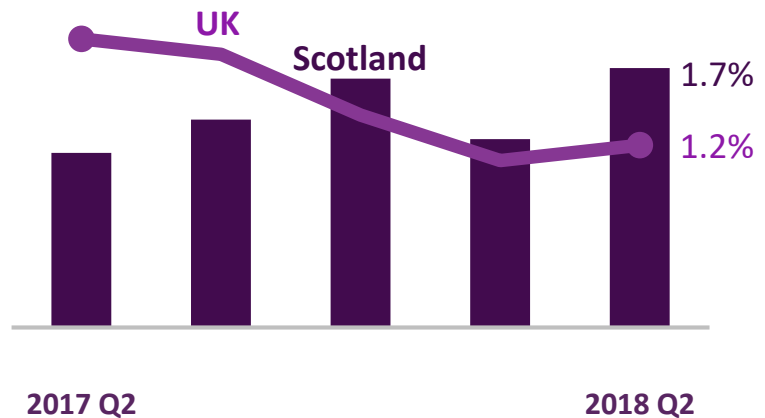


**Scottish GDP grew by 1.7% over the year**

Compared to the same time last year (2017 Q2), Scottish GDP has increased by 1.7%. This is unrevised from the first estimate published on 19 September.

Equivalent UK growth over the year was 1.2%.

Change in GDP compared to the same quarter last year



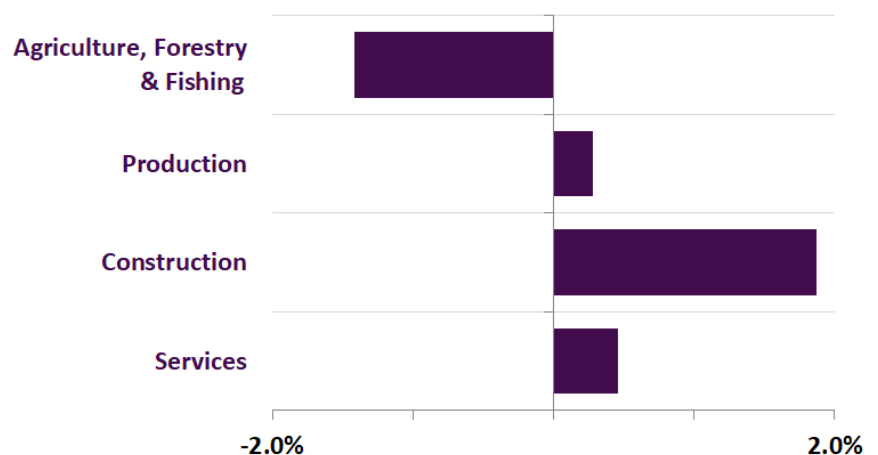
**Growth in Production, Services and Construction sectors**

In 2018 Q2, the Services sector increased by 0.5%

Output in the Production sector increased by 0.3%

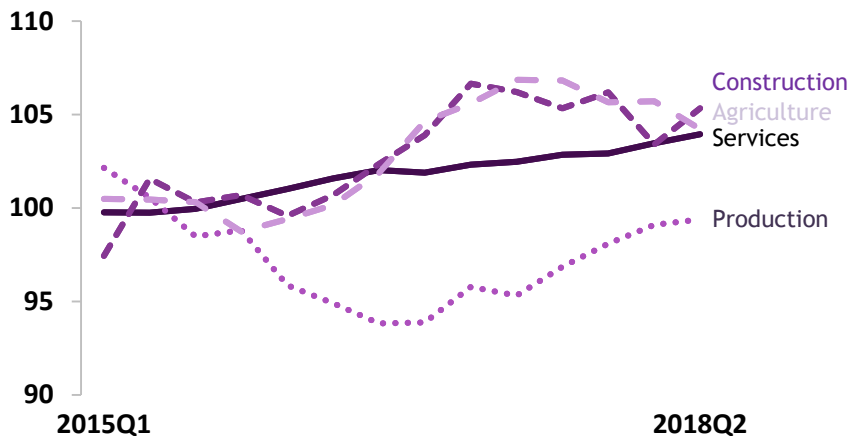
Output in Construction sector grew by 1.9%

### Services sector shows stable gains

The services sector of the Scottish economy has shown stable growth over recent years.

Production output has recovered after falling during 2015 and 2016, while construction output remains more volatile.

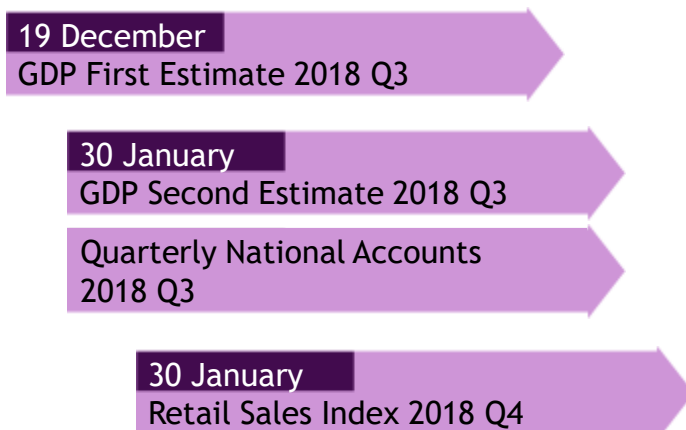
