

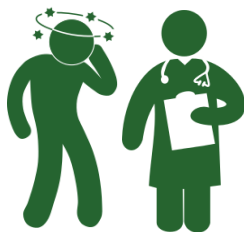
Scottish Cancer Patient Experience Survey

Planning for the next survey is underway! We are aiming for the survey to go **live in September 2018**. National and local level **results would then be published in Spring 2019**.



The survey will ask **around 8,000 people across Scotland** about their experiences of cancer care...

... from thinking that something might be wrong and receiving a diagnosis...



... through treatment and care...



... to the support they received after treatment.



Alongside a national report, survey results will be made available at NHS Board, Regional Cancer Network and Cancer Centre levels via an interactive dashboard.



These results will help to **inform local services** about peoples' experiences of cancer care. They will also **highlight areas of best practice and areas for improvement** across Scotland.
