

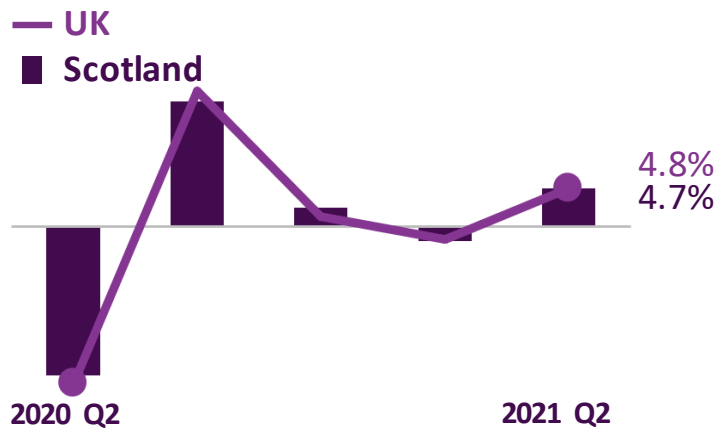


**GDP grew 4.7% in the second quarter of 2021**

Gross Domestic Product has increased by 4.7% during April to June.

During this period UK GDP increased by 4.8%.

Change in GDP compared to last quarter

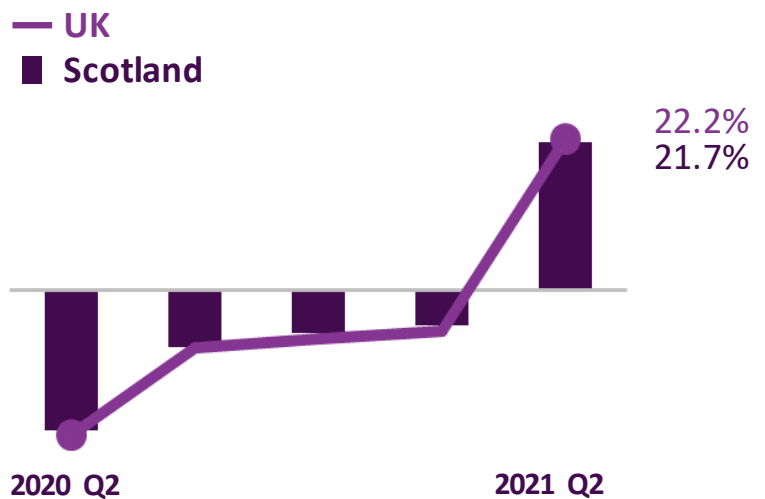


**Scottish GDP grew by 21.7% over the year**

Compared to the same time last year (2020 Q2), Scottish GDP has increased 21.7%.

Equivalent UK change over the year was 22.2%.

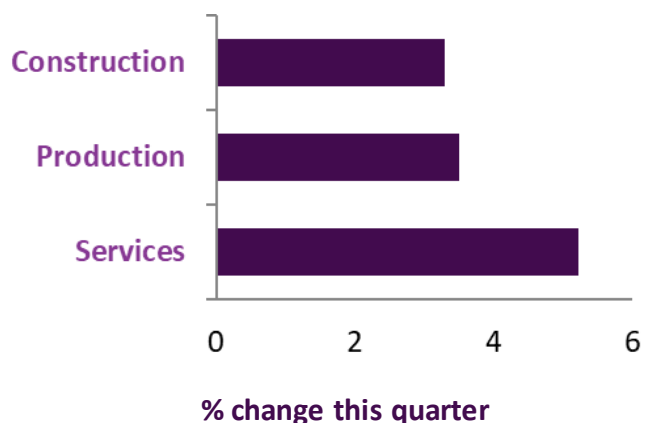
Change in GDP compared to the same quarter last year



**Positive quarter for Construction, Production, and Services**

In 2021 Q2, output in the Construction sector increased by 3.3%, output in the Production sector increased by 3.5% and Services sector output increased by 5.2%.

## GDP fell 9.6% in 2020

Between 2019 and 2020 (taking all four quarters of each year), Scottish GDP decreased by -9.6%.

Equivalent UK change in 2020 was -9.8%.
