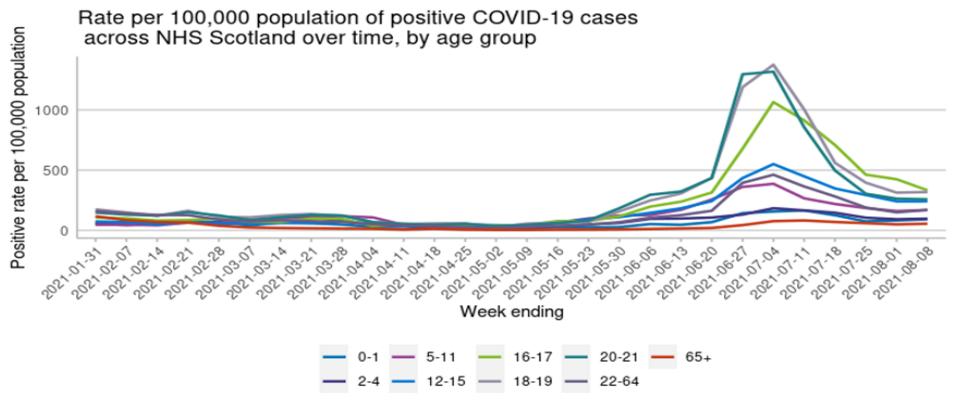
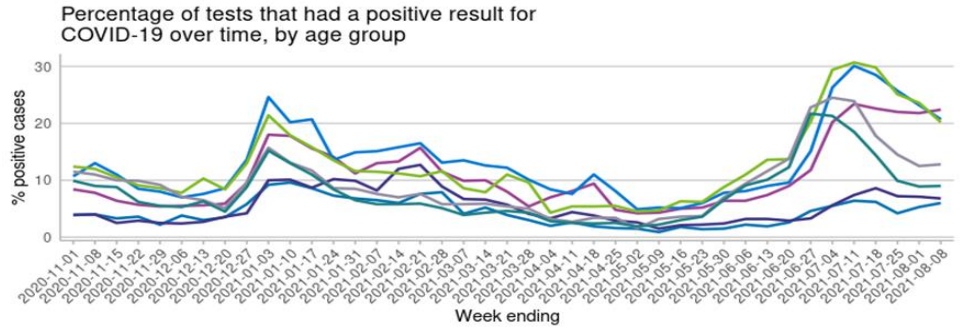
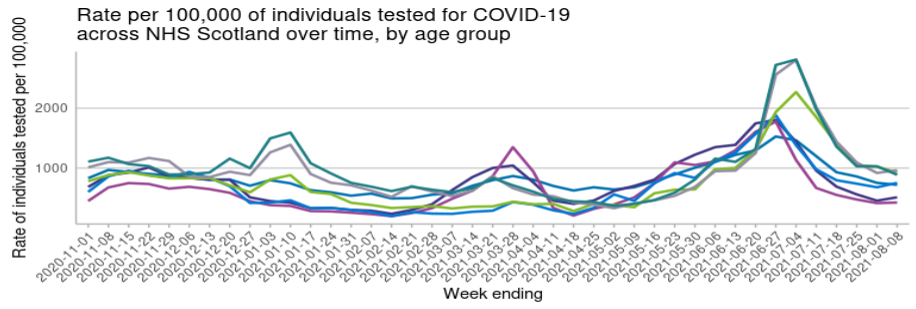


Covid-19 Education Recovery Group - Infographic

In the week ending 8th August 2021:

- The rate of testing was 525.2 per 100,000 children and young people aged 2-17 years.
- The percentage of tests that were positive was 17.9% in those aged 2-17 years; an decrease from 19.3% last week.
- The identified COVID-19 positive cases reflected a rate of 96.9 cases per 100,000 2-4 year olds, 169.0 cases per 100,000 5-11 year olds, 241.3 per 100,000 12-15 year olds and 332.3 cases per 100,000 16-17 year olds. The rate of cases per 100,000 of the general population was 154.0.
- This week, 183 (1.5%) childcare staff were absent due to Covid-19 related reasons [based on a 24% response rate].
