

Covid-19 Education Recovery Group - Infographic

In the week ending 11th April 2021:

- The rate of testing was 357.5 per 100,000 children and young people aged 2-17 years.
- The percentage of tests that were positive was 6.7% in those aged 2-17 years; an increase from 6.1% last week.
- The identified COVID-19 positive cases reflected a rate of 41.0 cases per 100,000 2-4 year olds, 44.9 cases per 100,000 5-11 year olds and 41.2 per 100,000 12-15 year olds and 55.7 cases per 100,000 16-17 year olds. The rate of cases per 100,000 of the general population was 34.3.


Staff and pupil attendance:

- Note that most local authorities remain on holiday this week – an update on school attendance will be provided next week.


On 13th April:

- 38,534 children were attending a childcare setting and 267 had a Covid-19 related absence. Note that not all open settings completed the survey and that these figures are an underestimate of the actual number of open settings and children attending. Figures are lower than usual due to holidays.


Rate per 100,000 of individuals tested for COVID-19 across NHS Scotland over time, by age group
