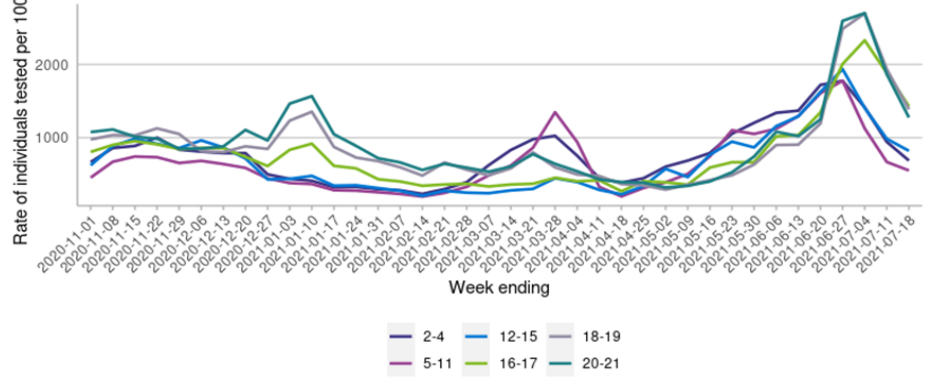


# Covid-19 Education Recovery Group - Infographic

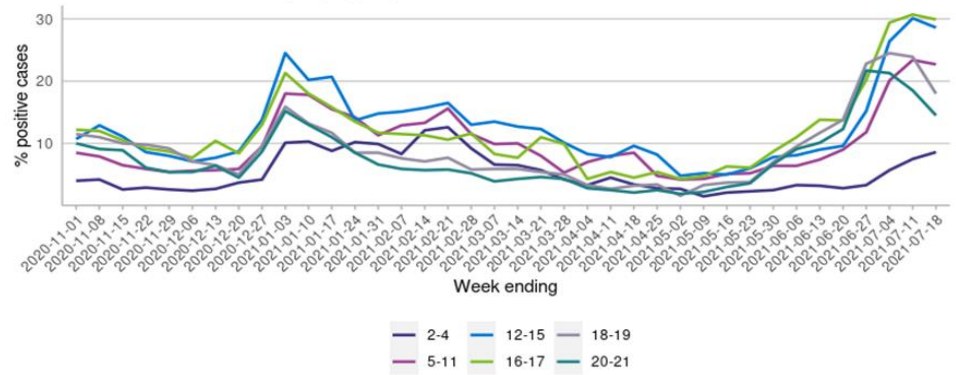
## In the week ending 18<sup>th</sup> July 2021:

- The rate of testing was 744.6 per 100,000 children and young people aged 2-17 years.
- The percentage of tests that were positive was 22.5% in those aged 2-17 years; a slight decrease from 22.8 % last week.
- The identified COVID-19 positive cases reflected a rate of 142.7 cases per 100,000 2-4 year olds, 217.4 cases per 100,000 5-11 year olds, 362.1 per 100,000 12-15 year olds and 721.0 cases per 100,000 16-17 year olds. The rate of cases per 100,000 of the general population was 252.7.
