

# Covid-19 Education Recovery Group - Infographic

As at 20th September 2020:

- There have been 704 children and young people aged 2-17 years in Scotland who have tested positive for COVID-19 since the start of the outbreak.

In the week ending 20<sup>th</sup> September 2020:

- There were 121 children and young people aged 2-17 years in Scotland who tested positive for COVID-19, among the 5,201 children and young people who were tested.

On 22<sup>nd</sup> September:

- Attendance in local authority schools was 93.1%, whilst the percentages of openings recorded as pupils not in school (non Covid-19 reasons) was 5.4%, and for not in school (Covid-19 related reasons) was 1.5%.

- 10,560 pupils were not in school either all or part of the day because of Covid-19 related reasons.

- 1,596 staff were absent due to Covid-19 related reasons, of which, 1,001 were teaching staff and 595 were other school-based staff.

- 72,681 children were attending a childcare setting and 992 had a Covid-19 related absence.

- 356 (2.0%) childcare staff were absent due to Covid-19 related reasons [based on a 48% response rate].
